The Ridge Cemetery Association Board met on Wednesday, December 12, 2018 at noon at the City Auditorium Meeting Room, Nick Lamme, President, presiding. Quorum established. Public Meeting was posted by Kim Koski.

The minutes of the September 12, 2018 meeting were emailed to everyone and copies were provided. Joanne Thietje made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Jim Manhart. Norma Jeanne, Jim, Kim, Nick, Joanne and Paul voted yes to approve the minutes. All approved and minutes will be filed.

Norma Jeanne presented the Treasurer's Report. As of December 12, 2018, the Ridge Cemetery Association Bank balance was \$13,869.32. \$775.00 addition was from donations and the rest was interest. This balance does not include a donation of \$200 from John Dobson, which has not been deposited. Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report was made by Joanne Thietje, seconded by Jim Manhart. Norma Jeanne, Jim, Kim, Nick, Joanne and Paul voted yes to approve the report. Motion carried and approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Boy Scout Headstone Straightening Project: Jeff called John Ramsey but no action has been taken. A suggestion to contact Yogi Martin was made. Kim Koski knows Yogi and will speak with him.

We received a letter informing us that we did not receive funds from the Keno grant/Walker Foundation due to limited funds available. We will re-apply for both grants. April 1, 2019 deadline. We will ask for \$10,000 with matching funds of \$10,000. If awarded, work will need to be done by August.

NEW BUSINESS

Kim Beam reported that the article on Ridge Cemetery ran in the Fremont Tribune with Tammy McKelghan writing the story. A few donations were received. As far as requesting donations, our time to do this is in May, when folks are visiting the cemetery and placing flowers on their loved ones graves. An updated list needs to be prepared by the City by April 15, 2019. Kim Beam volunteered to do this project from April 15-May 15, 2019 with the help of Norma Jeanne and anyone else.
