

WELCOME TO YOUR LIBRARY

Your library card is the key to check out materials from the library during regular hours or access e-books, e-magazines and e-resources over the web any hour of the day or night. Everyone is welcome to use all library resources within the library. To check out materials and use of e-resources outside of the library an account is need. A library account and card are available at no cost to customers who live within the city limits of Fremont. The library is a property tax supported service. For those outside of Fremont an account is available for a small fee. Replacement cards are \$1.

RESOURCES AND SERVICES

In Print -

Books for adults, teens and children, and in Large Print. Magazines and newspapers. A selection of books and magazines in Spanish.

Non-Print -

Books and music on CD. Playaways (digital audio book). Movies and informational videos on DVD.

e-resources– Downloadable books, audio books and magazines accessed via the library's website. Online resources support research for school assignments and personal interests. Available via the internet using your library barcode and PIN number.

Programs

Keene Memorial Library hosts book clubs, speakers, author signings, other informational and cultural offerings. Regularly scheduled, ongoing programming is provided to the community's youth:

For Children - Story Times, Baby Play/Toddler Play, crafts and book clubs year round. Summer Reading Program in June and July helps to maintain reading skills during the summer break and providing entertainment and craft opportunities to children.

For Teens – After school games, book clubs and a Teen Advisory Group. A Teen focused Summer Reading Program in June and July.

Computers -

Internet access, word processing and access to library e-resources. Designated computers provide access to children's games and age appropriate resources.

Wi-Fi is available. Printing is available for a small fee.

Welcome and Information Desk Services -

Library staff can assist you in finding materials in the library, identifying a new book or author to read and assist with research both in the library and by phone. A collection of resume and job search resources are nearby. Interlibrary loan service is available.

Genealogy / Local History -

Historic Fremont city directories, high school yearbooks and local histories are available to the genealogies. Fremont Tribune on microfilm and online access to genealogy resources.

Handicap Services -

Nebraska Library Commission provides "Talking Books" and Braille materials upon request.

Meeting Rooms -

Two rooms available for nonprofit/educational use with capacity ranging from 30 to 80. Check with staff for availability.

* There is a limit of 20 total items per card.


One (1) renewal allowed if item is not New or On Hold for another borrower.


