MEETING CALLED TO ORDER The Dangerous Animal Appeal Commission was called to order, a copy of the open meeting law is posted continually for public inspection located near the entrance door by the agendas.

ROLL CALL Roll call showed Members Pettit, Yerger, Bang and Elliot present; Hespen was absent.

1. Appoint Secretary. Elliot moved, seconded by Pettit to appoint Bang as Secretary. Voting Aye: Pettit, Yerger, Bang, Elliot. Motion carried
2. Appoint Chairman. Elliot moved, seconded by Bang to appoint Yerger as Chairman. Voting Aye: Pettit, Yerger, Bang, Elliot. Motion carried
3. Hear the appeal of David Lickteig. Following statements by the City and Appellant a vote was held to approve or deny the Animal's continued status as potentially dangerous. Voting approve: Bang. Voting deny: Pettit, Yerger, Elliot. The Commission finds that the animal will not be designated as potentially dangerous.
