DANGEROUS ANIMAL APPEAL COMMISSION MINUTES
May 31, 2023 – 2:30 PM

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER The Dangerous Animal Appeal Commission was called to order, a copy of the open meeting law is posted continually for public inspection located near the entrance door by the agendas.

ROLL CALL Roll call showed Members Yerger, Bang, and Elliot present.

REVIEW previous meeting minutes from 05/18/2023.

As presented: “Hear the appeal of David Lickteig. Following statements by the City and Appellant a vote was held to approve or deny the Animal’s continued status as potentially dangerous. Voting approve: Bang. Voting deny: Pettit, Yerger, Elliot. The Commission finds that the animal will not be designated as potentially dangerous.”

Voting deny: Yerger and Bang. The Commission finds that the animal will not be designated as dangerous. The Commission did affirm unanimously to uphold the previous potentially dangerous designation.
2. Hear the appeal of Katie Schulz. Following statements by the City and Appellant a vote was held to affirm, modify, or deny the Animal’s continued status as potentially dangerous. Voting affirm: Elliott. Voting deny: Yerger and Bang. The Commission finds that the animal will not be designated as dangerous. The Commission did affirm unanimously to uphold the previous potentially dangerous designation.

ADJOURNMENT Motion made by Bang, seconded by Elliott to adjourn; time: 3:52 P.M. Voting Yea: Yerger, Bang and Elliot. Motion carried.
