RX DRUG DROP BOX

The **Fremont Police Department** has a new tool to help prevent the abuse of prescription drugs. The **Rx Drug Drop Box** is located in the lobby of the police department located at 725 N. Park Ave., where prescription pills can be discarded. **The drop box is available from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Officers also will take pills at other times.**

The box was obtained through a grant from the National Association of Drug Diversion Investigators (NADDI). It's just one of three such drop boxes in the state, with the others located at the Blair Police Department and Keith County Sheriff's Office in Ogallala.

Only pills can be discarded in the drop box. Liquids, needles, thermometers and medical waste will not be accepted in the

This is offered in such a way that any participant will remain ANONYMOUS. No identifying information is maintained.



What CAN I turn in?

What you **CAN** turn into the Fremont Police Department RX DRUG DROP BOX

- Controlled Substance medications (Scheduled Drugs)
- Non-Controlled Substance (Rx) medications
- Over-the-counter (OTC) Medications
- Medication samples
- Vitamins
- Inhalers

What you **CANNOT** turn into the Fremont Police Department RX DRUG DROP BOX

- Any sharps such as: Needles, Syringes, Lancets
- Any Mercury or Cadmium Products such as: Thermometers & Batteries
- Disposal medical waste items such as: IV bags, Used Bandages, Gowns, or Bio-Hazard items
- Aerosol cans
- Chemicals or Disinfectants such as: Hydrogen peroxide
- Personal care products (non-medicated shampoo, etc)
- Liquids (syrups, etc.)
