

FREMONT DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES

CARE & SHARE PROGRAM

The Utility and Infrastructure Board established the CARE & SHARE PROGRAM to provide a means for voluntary contributions from customers to help other customers needing assistance paying their utility bills. In cooperation with the Fremont Area Coalition, assistance is provided for emergency payment of delinquent utility bills.

FUNDING

Customers may add donations to their monthly utility payments as a contribution to the CARE & SHARE PROGRAM. One-time donations are accepted at the office or may be mailed directly to 400 East Military. *Mark one-time donations as "Care & Share."*

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for assistance under this program, the applicant must:

- reside in the Fremont Department of Utilities service area,
- provide proof of income to agency administering the program, and
- have a delinquent residential utility bill, subject to termination.

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

Through a service agreement with the Fremont Department of Utilities, the Fremont Area Coalition administers the program. The Fremont Department of Utilities has no direct control over the CARE & SHARE disbursements.
